EARLY LEARNING CENTER

Welcome to The Mustard Seed Family. We are glad that you have chosen us. We look forward to a long partnership with you in this very important stage of your child's life. What to bring on the first day for all children:

- Extra set of clothes (including underwear and socks)
- Small bag or backpack
- Special small comfort item from home to make the transition as easy as possible
- Small tube of toothpaste (excluding infants)

Infants/Toddlers

- Formula/Baby Food/Cereal/Snacks
- Bottles (one per feeding plus one extra)
- Large package of diapers
- Wipes—in plastic box (then wipes refill packages are ok)
- Pacifier
- Diaper Rash Cream
- Feeding Plan (for all children not eating table food exclusively)

Sign In and Out

It is VERY important that as you come in and leave daily that you sign in through the key pad fingerprint system in the foyer. Please do not go through the doorway without doing so. This includes going into the classrooms because the door was already open. This is the center's way of recording who is in attendance at any given time. We will use this list in an emergency situation.

We will register you for your fingerprints on your child's first day.

Clothing

We are in the business of having fun while learning. We will have many activities that involve getting dirty. Please do not dress your child in clothes that you do not want to get dirty. Children learn through play...and our play is sometimes messy!

Communication

Keeping an open communication line open between the parents and the center is very important. Therefore we will provide information to you in many forms. First, each child will have a daily communication sheet that will be sent home in the afternoon.

We also have newsletters and reminders that are emailed to you. Please be sure to give the office your email address that is checked often so that you do not miss out on this important information. If at any time you have any questions or concerns, please contact your child's teacher or Ms. Roxy.
